**Subject:** Provider Rate Increases Effective 1/1/2024

This communication is to provide an update on the third phase of rate increases authorized under House Bill 2 (HB 2). The phase 3 HB 2 rate increases will go into effect with a January 1, 2024 effective date. A list of services impacted by the phase 3 HB 2 rate increases is provided below.

The publication of the updated fee schedule incorporating the phase 3 HB 2 rate increases has been delayed due to multiple HCPCS code updates from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services over the prior two months. However, NH Medicaid expects to publish the updated fee schedule, inclusive of the phase 3 HB 2 rate increases, prior to January 1, 2024. NH Medicaid will send a follow-up notification to all providers once the updated fee schedule has been published.

This Medicaid Rate Informational Item provides an overview of the appropriations made in HB 2 by service category.
