Subject: New COVID Vaccines and Administration Codes Effective 9/11/2023

The [FDA has approved and authorized for emergency use](#) updated [Moderna](#) and [Pfizer-BioNTech](#) COVID-19 vaccines for ages 6 months and older. These vaccines, formulated to more closely target currently circulating variants and provide better protection against serious consequences of COVID-19, are effective as of 9/11/2023. The vaccines have been updated to include a monovalent (single) component that corresponds to the Omicron variant XBB.1.5.

The federal government is not purchasing these new vaccine products.

Vaccines for children through 18 years of age are provided through the Vaccine for Children Program at no charge. The SL modifier is used when billing for these free vaccines through this program. Administration fees are paid by

Medicaid. Pharmacies cannot provide the vaccines that are available through the Vaccine for Children Program, including new codes 91318, 91319, 91320, 91321, 91322. Out of state providers should bill for these codes without the SL modifier.
