Subject: Code Change for Individualized SUD Recovery Support and Group SUD Recovery Support

EFFECTIVE May 1, 2022

Effective May 1, 2022, the following codes will be required for claims submitted for SUD Recovery Support Services of all Medicaid enrolled providers. These new codes replace the current code of T1012 that is unable to reimburse for multiple units and should not be used after **May 1, 2022**. **Any claims submitted with T1012 code will be denied reimbursement. Providers will be allowed to rebill the services using the new code if denied previously.**

Medical Claims billed on Form 1500 –Please use Form 1500 for all fee-for-service claims. These procedure codes should only be billed by Medicaid enrolled Outpatient, Comprehensive or Peer Recovery Programs. Please note that when a peer delivers services within a Medicaid enrolled Peer Recovery Program, the H0038 and H0038 HQ codes should be used *without the UD modifier*.

H0038 UD: Individualized Recovery Support 15 minute increments

H0038 UD HQ: Group Recovery Support 15 minute increments

DHHS-Program Integrity unit shall monitor the claims submissions for accuracy and conduct random samples to validate the correct use of coding with modifiers. Any non-compliant claims shall be subject to recovery.
